Support Fund of the Salzburg Chamber of Labor for students

For students of the Salzburg University of Applied Sciences who find themselves in a difficult social or financial situation, there is the possibility to apply for a one-time financial support through the fund of the Salzburg Chamber of Labour. The goal is to give students a bridging aid and thereby enable them to complete or continue their studies. Permanent support over several semesters is only possible in special emergency situations. On average, amounts equivalent to the tuition fee up to € 500 are paid out, in exceptional cases even more. The basic prerequisite for support is positive academic success.

Preconditions for support

- other possibilities of self-financing (earned income, assets, scholarship, etc.) must have been exhausted or applied for
- the student must be in a particularly difficult situation, possible reasons (exemplary):
 - particularly high costs due to illness, e.g: medication, therapy costs
 - loss of income (unemployment etc.)
 - No work permit
 - housing problems (rent increase, termination of the apartment)
 - unforeseeable "catastrophes", such as apartment fire, flood, etc.
 - increased care situation (children, relatives)
 - Care of children (single parents)
 - no possibility of support by private environment (parents)

Application procedure

Decision on the awarding

An FH committee decides on the approval of the funds and also their amount for each individual application. The applicant will be personally informed of an approval or rejection within a reasonable period of time. The personal data of the students will be treated absolutely confidentially by the committee members and will not be passed on to third parties.
