Learning Outcomes - The course aims to develop the following essential soft skills:

- experience & improve multicultural team collaboration
- increase cultural awareness and broaden perspectives
- adaptability to intercultural concepts & processes
- show empathy and recognise cultural sensitivities
- enhanced communication skills
- build cross-cultural relationships and trust
- mindful of assumptions, biases & stereotyping
- critical thinking surrounding meaning of conflict
- evaluate and apply theoretical models of culture
- analytical lens for critical incidences of cultural differences
- reflect on personal learning and development

Description:

This interactive course provides a rich space to enhance intercultural awareness and broaden perspectives. A focus of this course is on improving essential soft skills and capabilities for today and tomorrow's international workplace and personal life. Participating students come from multiple cultural backgrounds and will be stimulated to reflect on their own culture, learn how to share it and value other cultures. Build onto your existing experience and improve your communication skills through collaboration and exchanging intercultural knowledge. Your learning is supported by interactive discussions, collaboration games and tasks, case studies, theory, literature, and audio-visual clips.
